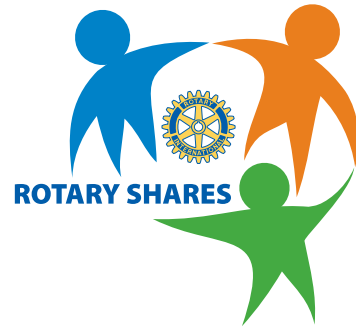


Goals Worksheet

In order for goals to be successful they must be:

- **Shared.** Those who participate in setting a goal and developing strategies to achieve that goal are committed to implementing it. Ask your Board of Directors for their input – they will help you succeed.
- **Measurable.** A goal should provide a tangible point to pursue. Is there a way to measure its success?
- **Challenging.** A goal should be ambitious enough to go beyond what the club has accomplished in the past. You may want to set a goal and then a stretch goal that would "knock out" your wildest dreams!
- **Achievable.** Rotarians should be able to accomplish the goal with the resources available.
- **Time Specific.** A goal should have a deadline or timeline.
