 - Planning process
- ❖ Details of the project, including
 - Project dates
 - Cost, if any, and sources of funding
 - Nature of other club involvement
 - Number of people affected
- ❖ Projects will be judged on their
 - Creativity & originality
 - Short and long-term impact on community, particularly its children, and the opportunity for making a difference in peoples’ lives.
 - Ability to actively engage club members
 - Adherence to The 4-Way Test

Basic Needs projects are defined as projects that improve the lives of children in the areas of literacy, health & hunger or water management
