Clubs are also referred to the District 6400 **Basic Needs Award** application if they wish to be considered for additional recognition for exceeding the criteria outlined here.

- Our club was involved in at least one Basic Needs project in *our community* between July 1, 2008 and April 1, 2009.
 - Involvement includes direct financial support to a local project by the club and/or;
 - A local project designed by and with participation of members of the club (can also be conducted in conjunction with other Rotary clubs).

- Our club was involved in at least one Basic Needs project *internationally* between July 1, 2008 and April 1, 2009.
 - Involvement includes direct financial support to an international project by the club and/or;
 - An international project designed by and with participation of members of the club (can also be conducted in conjunction with other Rotary clubs).

Basic Needs projects are defined as projects that improve the lives of children in the areas of literacy, health & hunger or water management
